All slides scanned from 17/6/15 onwards have been scanned on the Epson V800.

I am now re-scanning Bhutan slides which I had already processed with the CanoScan in past years, since the Epson, as well as being quick and easy to use, gives a much better result. At the same time, I am reviewing **all** colour slides taken in Bhutan since my first visit in early 1980, and selecting more for scanning for this archive.
